2018 VICTORIAN RPSBS STALLION SERVICE SILENT AUCTION CONDITIONS

The 2018 Stallion Service Silent Auction will open on Monday 16th July 2018 with bids to be received no later than 6:00 pm Friday 28th September 2018 - in time for the 2018 breeding season.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be a starting bid of \$300 (*GST inclusive*) imposed on each stallion to begin the bidding process. Bids above this will be accepted in \$50 increments only. A \$250 (GST Inc) handling fee is payable on each service in addition to the bid amount.

At the close of bidding, the successful bidder will be notified. If, before the close of bidding your amount has been outbid, all attempts will be made to contact you to enable you to submit a further bid. At the close of auction a tax invoice will be sent to the successful bidder for payment within 14 days.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Acceptance of any bid will be subject to the conditions below and any additional conditions specified by the Stallion owner/s.
2. Auction rules specify that all bidders must be aged eighteen years or above.
3. There will be a starting bid of \$300 (GST inclusive) imposed on each stallion to begin the bidding process. Bids above this will be accepted in \$50 increments only.
4. A \$250 handling fee will also be paid in addition to the bidding price. This handling fee will be paid directly to the stallion owner prior to or upon the arrival of the mare at stud.
5. The 2018 Stallion Service Silent Auction will open on Monday 16th July 2018 with bids to be received no later than 6:00 pm Friday 28th of September 2018.
6. In the event that two bids are received for the same amount the bid which was lodged on the earlier date shall stand.
7. Successful bidders will be notified within 7 days of the closing date.
8. The Stallion service to be used during the 2018 breeding season.
9. Acceptance of any bid shall be at the sole discretion of the Committee of the Victorian Branch of the Riding Pony Stud Book Society Ltd.
10. In the event of your bid being accepted payment must be made to the Victorian Riding Pony Stud Book Society Ltd. in full within 14 days of the tax invoice being sent. Initially, all attempts will be made to notify the successful bidder by phone. Please note, that by submitting a bid, you make yourself liable to pay that amount should your bid be successful.

11. Where a live foal Guarantee applies – a live foal is defined as a foal that lives, breathes and suckles for twenty-four hours after birth. If the mare aborts or a live foal does not result from this service a free return service will be provided in the 2019 breeding season only to the mare (provided she is still owned by the mare owner) served by the stallion (provided he is still alive, fertile and still owned by the stallion owner) with a veterinary certificate confirming the mare aborted following the 45 day pregnancy test or that the foal did not live, breath or suckle for the first twenty four hours.
12. Where free return applies – a free return means that the service fee will not be charged but all other fees and costs will still apply including the handling fee.
13. It is the responsibility of the mare owner to confirm that the mare is free from contagious disease and is in normal breeding condition.
14. The stallion owner will make every effort to care for, and competently handle and feed your mare whilst at stud but the stallion owner or the Victorian RPSBS will not accept any liability whatsoever for any loss, damage, illness or accident of the mare (and/or foal in utero or at foot) whilst at stud. Insurance of your mare is advised.
15. The mare may not be released from the stallion owner's property until all outstanding agistment and vet costs have been paid in full.
16. The mare owner agrees to pay all veterinary accounts. This may be paid directly to the veterinary surgery and/or the stallion owner by agreement.
17. The mare owner agrees to abide by any delivery conditions imposed by the stallion owner.
18. Should the stallion die or become unfit for service, this agreement shall become invalid and the Victorian Branch of the Riding Pony Studbook Society Ltd. shall refund the full bid amount.
19. In lodging a bid you agree to and accept the conditions imposed by the stallion owner.
20. The bidder understands the successful bid is at the discretion of the Victorian Branch of the Riding Pony Stud Book Society Ltd. selection panel.
21. The bidder agrees that the bid fee is confidential and undertakes not to discuss or disclose any successful bid fee with any other person.
22. The bidder and the stud accept, that the condition of the mare on arrival at the stud and the care of the mare whilst at the stud, are outside the control and responsibility of the organisers of the Victorian Branch of the Riding Pony Stud Book Society Ltd.
23. The winning bidder accepts that the service is non-transferable, and must be used solely by that person unless prior consent is authorised by the stallion owner. A mare nomination form must be completed by each winning bidder, outlining details of the mare to be used for the stallion service. The winning bidder agrees that the nominated mare must meet all requirements imposed by the stallion owner.
24. The Victorian RPSBS Ltd. Committee reserves the right to alter these terms & conditions if and/or when the need shall arise.
